2026 LARAMIE JUBILEE DAYS KID'S HORSE SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

The Kid's Horse Show will be held **Saturday, July 4, 2026** at the Albany County Fairgrounds. Classes start promptly at **9:00 a.m.** These events are for local youngsters, but "out of towners" staying with relatives may also enter. This is not an "up tight" regimented horse show. All contestants must have a release form signed by a parent or guardian. Youngsters will not be allowed to participate without a release. Entries must be received by **June 26th, 2026**. There is a **\$25/kid** late fee this year.

Buckles will be given to winners in all events, except Tiny Tots. All expenses are paid by DONATIONS. Please mail all donations to: Julie Lorenzi, P.O. Box 332, Laramie, Wyo. 82073. **Donations are welcome and appreciated.**

Age requirements are as follows: Tiny Tot lead class is for ages 1 to 6; Pee Wees are ages 7 years and under; Lil Bits are ages 8-10; Juniors are ages 11-13; and Seniors are ages 14-16. **AGES ARE DETERMINED AS OF JULY 1, 2026.**

The Tiny Tot Lead Class is for ages 1 to 6 who need assistance. They may be mounted on any size horse or pony and led by a responsible person. Each child will receive a ribbon and gift for participation; but there will not be a winner or any placing in this event. A Tiny Tot lead in any other event, led by a responsible adult, will be for **exhibition only!**

The Pee Wee Pony Class is for ages seven and under. The pony for this event should not be over 54 inches tall. The pony or rider in this class cannot be entered in any of the Rider Classes.

The Pee Wee Walk-Trot is for youngsters who have not learned to lope yet. They will not be asked to lope. In the Pee Wee Rider Class they will be asked to lope their horses. Enter your child in the class you think best, but not in both.

The Rider Classes will be judged on the contestant's ability to ride and handle his/her mount. They will circle at a walk, trot, lope, reverse the circle, lineup and back. The riders may post if they choose; and any equipment such as chain curbs, tie downs, etc. may be used. Bridles are required. These are meant to be "fun events" for kids who like to ride.

The Barrel Race will be the Cloverleaf Pattern. Only one barrel race contestant will be allowed in the closed arena at one time. The gate will remain closed; the gate supervisors will provide entrance and exit from the arena. This will also apply to the other timed events. **Any led participant will be exhibition only.**

The Keyhole Pattern has a circle diameter of 20 feet and the neck is 6 feet long and 4 feet wide. Contestants will cross a starting line, go into the circle, turn around and return through the neck of the key, and cross the beginning line for the finish. If the horse touches the outline of the keyhole, it is an automatic disqualification. Parents are advised to make a pattern at home with lime or flour, so that the horse gets used to the white line. **Any led participant will be exhibition only.**

Dummy Roping will be for ages as follows: Tiny Tots for ages 5 and under; each child will receive a ribbon and gift for their participation. Pee Wees are ages 6-7; Lil Bits are ages 8-10; Juniors are ages 11-13; and Seniors are ages 14-16. No horse required; ropes will be provided. Two attempts will be given at each distance. First place will receive a buckle, with the exception of Tiny Tots; Second, Third, and participants will receive a ribbon.

ALL CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED. CONCESSION STANDS WILL BE AVAILABLE.
